We would like to invite you to our church this Christmas time. Please see overleaf for our service times. This year is particularly complicated so we are having to send this out now so that pre-booking can take place effectively. Once seating is confirmed you will be asked to send a stamped addressed envelope to Rev Simon Tillotson at the Vicarage, Church Street, Whitstable, CT5 IPG and the tickets will be posted to you. Please do not send in an envelope till your seats have been confirmed. Services on Christmas Eve and close to Christmas Eve are likely to go the quickest.

All tickets are free of charge. We are though asking all those attending to make a donation to All Saints to help with our financial deficit for the year which is considerable due to the loss of hall and wedding income this year.

Sadly singing is currently not permitted in our churches but we will be listening to carols, hearing readings and poems, and reflecting on the true meaning of Christmas.

If we have to cancel because of increasing tightening of restrictions we will email all those who have contacted us.

2 metre distancing is required for those not in household groups so therefore only 48 adults and children in total are permitted at each event. Facemasks are compulsory due to government law. Please arrive early so you can be seated at 2 metre distance from those outside your household or bubble.

We are keeping some tickets back for those not on email.

## What is the content of each service and when do they take place?

**Sacred Space** – An hour of reflective Christmas music with readings and prayers and periods of silence.

These will take place on Wednesday December 2nd and Monday 21<sup>st</sup>
December at 8pm, finishing at 8.45pm

**Children's Christmas Service** – Listening to joyful Christmas carols many with a youthful theme and a Christmas message with prayers suitable for all ages.

These will take place from 4pm to 4.45pm on Wednesday December 2<sup>nd</sup>, Saturday December 5<sup>th</sup>, Friday December 11<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday December 16<sup>th</sup>, Saturday December 19<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday December 23<sup>rd</sup> and Christmas Eve, (Thursday December 24<sup>th</sup>). An additional service on Christmas Eve following the same format will take place from 2pm to 2.45pm.

There is no Christingle service this year due to the health and safety aspects of the service.

**Christmas Carol Service** – Listen to joyful Christmas carols, hear Bible readings and prayers, and a message from the Vicar or whoever else is taking the service. Suitable for adults and older children but probably not very young children.

These will take place from 7pm to 7.45pm on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> December, Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> December, Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> December, Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December, Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> December and Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December

The Christmas Eucharistic Feast – Holy Communion services where we listen to carols and readings and Holy Communion is available in bread form only using social distancing and all other health precautions.

Midnight Mass – Christmas Eve at 11.15pm Christmas Day 8am Holy Communion (Book of Common Prayer) 9.30am Holy Communion (Book of Common Prayer)
